



BA A490B ALASKA TRIBAL NATIONS **ALASKA NATIVE BUSINESS MANAGEMENT**

The Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act had a profound impact on the formation and development of tribes in Alaska. In this course, we will explore the history, role, and jurisdiction of Alaska Native tribes, including their relationships with Alaska Native organizations and corporations.

This course explores the history of tribes in Alaska and includes contemporary issues affecting tribes today. The two day, 8 hour per day class format, provides an environment for in-depth discussion with Alaska Native tribal leaders. This class also provides practical instruction for tribal administrators, council members and tribal members on topics such as: PL 638 contracting and compacting, lands into trust and self-determination.

The class meets at UAA's University Center, classroom 146 all day on Thursday and Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on March 2 & 3. Late registration permitted for this course, however, seats are limited.
