



## TOM CASE LEADERSHIP FELLOWS PROGRAM APPLICATION

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Tom Case Leadership Fellows Program prepares UAA College of Business and Public Policy (CBPP) students to be future leaders who meet the needs of Alaska organizations through leadership, professional development programs and mentoring. The program is a co-curricular mentoring program for graduate and senior-level undergraduate students who are committed to leadership and personal and professional development. It is specifically focused on developing the future leaders of Anchorage and Alaska and encompasses a variety of leadership developmental activities.

### PROGRAM COMPONENTS

- **MENTORING:** Students are matched with community business leaders from their respective major/discipline. Students interact with leaders in the business community to develop one-on-one relationships that foster rich leadership development experiences
- **NETWORKING:** Mentors and students attend meetings and sessions sponsored by the CBPP that are designed to nurture the mentor and protégé relationship while providing opportunities for networking
- **COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT:** Students engage and participate in events for the Tom Case Leadership Fellows, Jr. Program – a leadership development program for excellent students at Clark Middle School
- **STUDENT ENGAGEMENT:** Students are encouraged to participate in the MBA Student Association – a UAA Club whose role is to provide networking opportunities for MBA students and offer input to MBA faculty and administration on program direction

### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Declared CBPP Graduate student or
- Undergraduate admitted to upper division standing
- Enrolled for the full academic year (both Fall and Spring Semesters)
- Required to meaningfully participate in the above-mentioned activities
- Required to have a faculty sponsor. The role of the faculty sponsor is to help identify a mentor for the applicant. The faculty sponsor must be listed on the application at submission. If an applicant has identified a potential mentor prior to submission, a faculty sponsor is not required. While applicants are not required to identify a mentor, we will consider an applicant's request to invite their proposed mentor to participate in the program.
