¹ The BA Economics degree allows 45-53 credits of elective courses. We recommend the student consider an accompanying minor. All courses required for this degree must be at the 100-level or above. Upper division electives must be at the 300 or 400 level.

² These courses are prerequisites for other program required courses. For this reason BA ECON majors are to complete their math requirements early in their program. Students planning on graduate school are advised to take the entire calculus sequence (MATH 251, 252 and 253).

³ ECON 201 and ECON 202 cannot be used to satisfy the Social Science GER requirement for this degree.

⁴ Effective spring 2010 semester students must take BA 273 Introduction to Statistics for Business and Economics.

⁵ No more than a total of 6 credits earned in an Independent Study, or ECON 454 Economics Internship, may be used to satisfy requirements for the major (6 credits of Independent Study or 3 credits of Independent Study and 3 credits of ECON 454).

NOTE: A total of 120 credits are required for the BA degree of which 48 credits must be upper division. Students must complete at least 12 credits of their Economics courses in residence at UAA.
