Option to take CIO 260A for the Written Communication Skills Requirement applies to AAS degrees only. Students planning to pursue baccalaureate degrees can maximize transferability of their credits by taking **ENGL 212**.

**NOTE:** A total of 60-61 credits is required for this associate degree. Students planning on seeking a BBA degree in the College of Business and Public Policy must complete all business courses with a grade of C or better.
