⁶ Students must complete three credits of Alaska Native-Themed GER as well as three credits of Diversity & Inclusion GER coursework from the approved GER list. However, the same course cannot meet both the AKN and DI requirements. If overlap occurs with a separate, existing Tier II GER category, then for this planning sheet, students will fulfill these 3 credits with an Elective instead (see note 1 above).

⁷ 3 credits of 200-level or above business elective (ACCT, BA, CIS, ECON, or LOG).

⁸ It is recommended Accounting majors take ACCT 101 and 102 Principles of Financial Accounting I and II in place of ACCT 201.

NOTE: A total of 120 credits is required for the BBA degree, 42 of which must be upper-division. At least 50% of the business credits (ACCT, BA, CIS, ECON, LGOP and LOG) required for the BBA degree must be earned at the University of Alaska Anchorage. **A grade of C or better is required for all major requirements.**
