However, the same course cannot meet both the AKN and DI requirements. If overlap occurs with a separate, existing Tier II GER category, then for this planning sheet, students will fulfill these 3 credits with an Elective instead (see note 1 above).

NOTE: A total of 120 credits is required for the BBA degree, 45 of which must be upper-division. At least 50% of the business credits (ACCT, BA, CIS, ECON, LGOP and LOG) required for the BBA degree must be earned at the University of Alaska Anchorage. **A grade of C or better is required for all major requirements. This is a suggested sequence for taking courses and is not intended to take the place of the program requirements listed in the current UAA Catalog.
